


History – Dental School

 Formal education in dentistry originated in 1840 when the Baltimore College of Dental Surgery was chartered by the General Assembly of Maryland.

...Horace H. Hayden, M.D., D.D.S. and Chapin A. Harris, M.D., D.D.S., two dental practitioners who recognized the need for formal education.

 BCDS served as the prototype for dental schools gradually established in other American cities...with equal emphasis on sound knowledge of general medicine and development of the skills of dentistry.








History – Dental School


- BCDS enjoys one of the most advanced dental education facilities in the world.

- The total cost...near \$150 million.



History – Medical School

- University of Maryland School of Medicine is the fifth oldest medical school in the United States.
- The medical school includes Davidge Hall, which was built in 1812 and is the oldest building in the Northern Hemisphere in continuous use for medical education and is designated a National Historic Landmark.








John Beale Davidge – 1st Dean

History – Medical School

- First medical school in US to build its own hospital for clinical instruction Opened in 1823.
 - UMMC is now on that site.



History - R Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center

Nation's first and only integrated trauma center was founded by R. Adams Cowley, who is considered the father of trauma medicine..."the golden hour". The first facility in the world to treat shock.


